



**Can you identify these wildflowers?
No? Some of them?**

All of them, plus another 170 or so species, can be found on the Denso Marston Nature Reserve off Otley Road in Baildon (not all at the same time of year). For the third year in succession, the **Friends of Denso Marston Nature Reserve** will be providing **four Wildflower Identification sessions**, led by Harry Allenby. If you would like to learn more about wildflowers, these sessions could be for you.

We have a fully equipped classroom on the reserve, where all the books, guides & magnifiers you will need are there for your use. We also have toilet and tea making facilities.



The sessions will be held at 1pm on the first Saturdays of March, April, June and July, 2017.

You can sign up by ringing warden Steve Warrillow on his mobile (07919 525913), or simply come down to the reserve on a Wednesday morning at 10am to have a look at our facilities, at a time when a few of us will be working there. Numbers are limited so, if you are interested, do act quickly.

There will also be three wildflower walks, led by Harry Allenby, on 11 March, 13 May & 22 July.
